The 'before' condition of this Belmont kitchen wasn't pretty. The Remodeling Company gutted the original kitchen and built an addition that contains not only a spacious new kitchen but also a sunny breakfast room and family room. Like many of today's new kitchens, this one includes access to cable and the Internet, as well as custom-built cabinetry that has a furniture-like style and finish.

At the beginning of this project, this Brookline home had already been converted once – from its single-family origins to a two-family house. The Remodeling Company converted it back into a single-family house. The work included gutting two kitchens and building one spectacular replacement – while the homeowners, their two children and a dog continued to live in the house during construction.



### Challenge

Creating separate kitchen, dining and sitting areas that flow together naturally in one large open space.

This 1930s Wellesley house underwent a major renovation.
